

## WINTER MILLAGE INFORMATION

Winter tax bills are levied and payable December 1 and must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of February (or the next business day if it falls on a holiday or weekend). Any payment not received by 5:00 p.m. is considered delinquent. March 1 all delinquent taxes are turned over to the Eaton County Treasurer, who adds penalty and 1% interest per month or part of a month, until paid in full. Below is a list of millage rates that appear on the winter tax bills along with a short explanation of each. Taxes paid are distributed to the taxing authorities within 10 days after the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of every month.

**EATON CO JAIL** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to fund the building and daily operations of running the jail. This was approved by voters in 2006\* (expires 2026\*).

**EATON CO 911** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to fund the Eaton County Consolidated Dispatch Authority. It was approved by voters in 2019\* (expires 2023\*).

**EATON CO EATRAN** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to fund the daily operations of running a fixed route public transportation system in Eaton County. It was approved by voters in 2020\* (expires 2026\*).

**EATON CO JUVENIL** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to fund the building and daily operations of running the juvenile home. It was approved by voters in 2019\* (expires 2023\*).

**EATON CO MED CAR** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to fund the building and daily operations of running the Eaton County Medical Care Facility. It was approved by voters in 2007\* (expires 2026\*).

**EATON CO ROAD** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to help the county with maintaining all of Eaton County roads. It was approved by voters in 2014\* (expires 2026\*).

**EATON CO PARKS** - This millage is levied by Eaton County to maintain all county parks and to help develop, expand and maintain the new Crandell Park. It was approved by voters in 2022\* (expires 2032\*).

**TWP OPERATING** - This millage is levied by Eaton Rapids Township for the daily operations to run the Township. It was approved by voters in 1978\*.

**ER SCH OPER** - This millage is levied by the Eaton Rapids Public School District on properties without a principal residence exemption (PRE). This includes all businesses with industrial, commercial, agricultural property and second homes. This was established by the Revised School Code Act (Act 451) of 1976 to cover general operating activities. This was approved in 2012\* (expires in 2023\*).

**ER SCH DEBT** - This millage is levied by the Eaton Rapids Public School District. This bond is a ZERO increase to the current tax rate and simply allows the repayment date to move from 2028 to 2035 with the EXISTING 7.0 mills, which is used for infrastructure and technology upgrades.

**ER SCH SINK** – This millage is levied by the Eaton Rapids Public School District which is used for erecting, furnishing and equipping a gymnasium addition to Lockwood Elementary School; remodeling,

furnishing and refurbishing and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring and installing instructional technology in school buildings; purchasing school buses; erecting, preparing, developing, improving and equipping athletic fields, facilities and structures; and preparing, developing, improving and equipping playgrounds and sites. This was approved by voters in 2020\* (expires 2025\*).

CHAR SCH OPER – This millage is levied by the Charlotte Public School District on properties without a principal residence exemption (PRE). This was established by the Revised School Code Act (Act 451) of 1976 to cover general operating activities.

CHAR SCH DEBT – This millage is levied by the Charlotte Public School District which is used for erecting additions to, remodeling, including security improvements to, furnishing and refurbishing and equipping and re-equipping existing school buildings; erecting, furnishing and equipping a new agricultural learning building and a support building; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; purchasing school buses; and equipping developing and improving athletic facilities, play fields, playgrounds, driveways, parking areas, and sites. This was approved by voters in Debt 2016\* (expires 2027\*).

CHAR SCH REC - this millage is levied by the Charlotte Public School District which is used for the purpose of providing funds for operating a system of public recreation and playgrounds. This was approved by voters in 2019\* (expires 2022\*).

EATN RESA SCH OPER - This millage is levied by Eaton RESA to be used for general operating activities. It was approved by the voters in 1978\* (and doesn't expire).

EATN RESA SP ED - This millage is levied by Eaton RESA and used for Center-based programs and transportation for Eaton RESA service area Special Education students, related service staff (speech, social workers, school psychologists, etc.) deployed to local districts, and disburse Special Ed funds to local districts to help offset their Special Education costs. It was approved by the voters in 1985\* (and doesn't expire).

EATN RESA VOC ED - This millage is levied by Eaton RESA to be used to prepare Eaton RESA service area students for career ready opportunities. It was approved by the voters in 1973\* (and doesn't expire).

ER DIST LIB – This millage is levied by the Eaton Rapids Area District Library (ERADL) services the residents of the City of Eaton Rapids, **Eaton Rapids Township**, and Hamlin Township, with around 12,421 individuals in total. The library's mission is to provide services necessary to meet the community's educational, informational, recreational, and cultural needs. ERADL strives to be an innovative community hub for all Eaton Rapids residents. Approved by the voters in 2018\* (expires 2027\*).
